TPI's accredited (Accrediting Commission International) Bible college curriculum is now available. It includes: 1) CD notes for classes for: Associate, Bachelor, Masters and Doctorate degrees in Biblical Studies; 2) DVD lectures for all notes; and, 3) textbooks supporting all curricula. The final step of transferring all of these materials to trained professors in each country has begun. This year, Dr. Coke installed the leaders for India and South East Asia to carry on The Timothy Program. The Rev. Sam Bakther John (seated far left) has accepted the position of President, Timothy Program India. The Rev. Emmanuel Paul (seated right) has accepted the position of Vice-president/Treasurer, Timothy Program India. The Rev. Edwin Felicie (bottom left photo), Jackson, New Jersey, U.S.A., has accepted the



position of Director, Timothy Program India. Over the next five years, Dr. Coke will transfer all the responsibilities to sustain the growing number of India TPI campuses until Messiah returns. The Timothy Program India Board of Directors is: President, Sam Bakther John; Vice-president/Treasurer, Emmanuel Paul; Director, Paul Billy Arnold: Director of TPI Indian Affairs, Edwin Felicie; and, Director, Karl Coke. 
