400 Delegates at Le Meridien Hotel, Coimbatore, Tamil Nadu, India for Hebrew Conference
4th Annual TPI Hebrew Conference Held in Coimbatore

There were 400 delegates from five states in India, Singapore, Germany and Sri Lanka.
