



Lazarus Rajkumar (pictured on Felicie's right), Pastor, Christian Assembly, Dindigul, Tamil Nadu, India. Rev. Felicie taught in English and pastors John and Rajkumar translated into Tamil. In their turn, pastors John and Rajkumar "re-taught" the lessons making certain the students understood and followed correctly in the Beginners Hebrew workbook written by Dr. Coke. Each student received notes, flashcards and a DVD.


