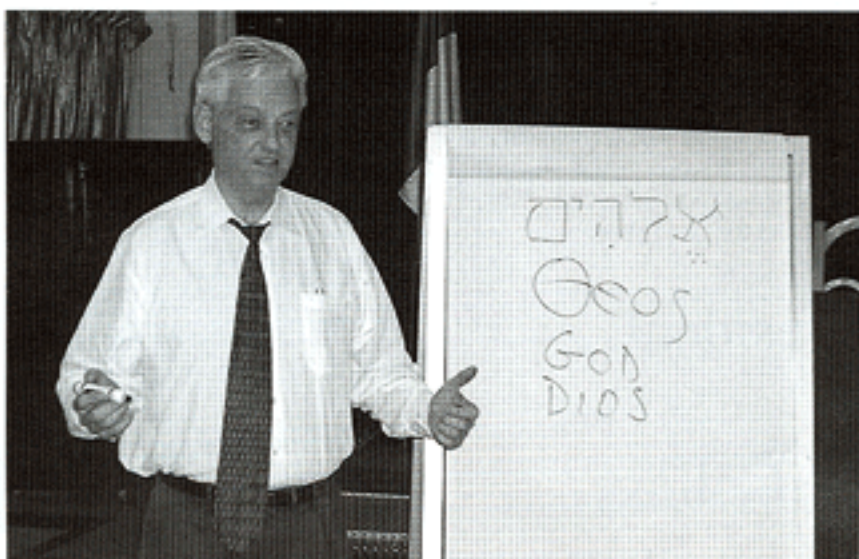

Mexico Bible College Receives TPI Curriculum

The Timothy Program International held its first 4 classes for the Mexico Bible College. The TPI curriculum was Level One, Quarter One. The subjects covered were "Salvation," "Bible," "Water Baptism" and "Messiah." Dr. Coke (right) is explaining how the curriculum is designed to lead Spanish-speaking



students from Spanish back to Hebrew (the text of the OT). The students studied for 4 days and then passed their exams. The Mexico Bible College will be using all three levels of the Timothy Program curriculum. The first 4 of 8 quarters of Level One curriculum have been translated into Spanish by Yohanán Salamanca.

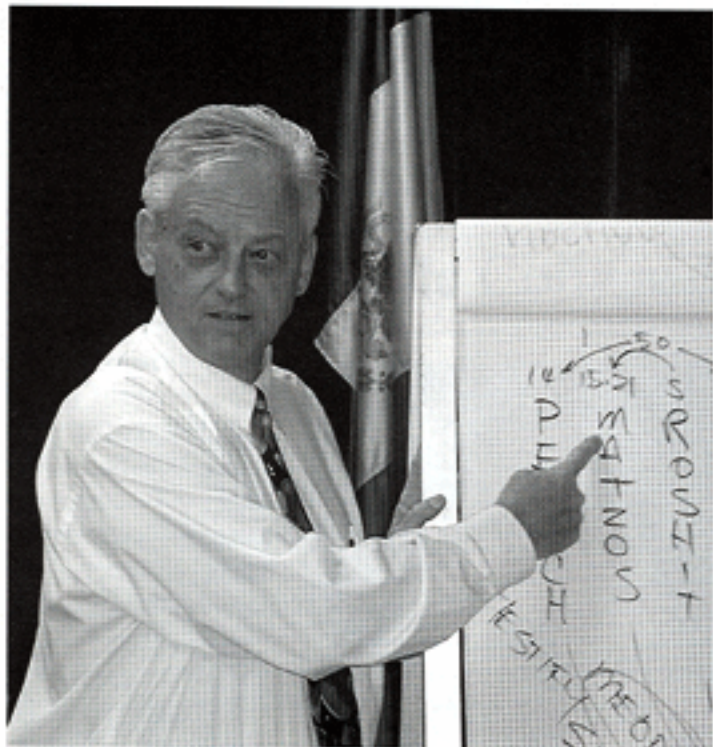
The New President of Mexico Bible College

(Below) The students at the first classes held by the Mexico Bible College at the Mexico Bible Society facilities in Mexico City. Each student was provided a complete workbook containing all the notes used by each professor. They were provided in Spanish. All lectures were either taught in Spanish or translated into Spanish. The four classes were: "Salvation" taught by Dr. John Loper; "Bible" taught by Rev. Yohanán Salamanca; "Water Baptism" taught by Dr. Clifford Denton; and, "Messiah" taught by Dr. Karl Coke. Exams were taken in each of the four classes. Upon completion of the exam, each student was awarded a diploma. Upon completing all 8 quarters of Level One, a student is then qualified to begin the 4-year Bible college program. When a student earns a Bachelor of Bible Studies degree, he is then qualified to enter Level Three of the TPI program to earn a Masters then a Doctoral degree.

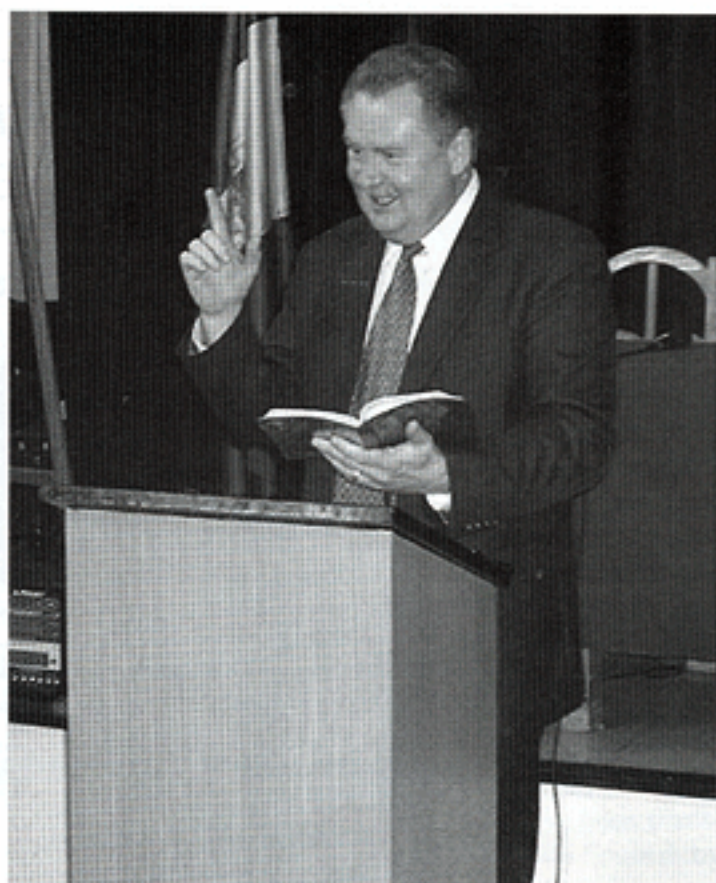


The Students
